I would like to extend a welcome to prospective parents to invite you to visit The Boswells School to take part in our summer term events for parents and potential students.

Due to the popularity of our Autumn tours we are now offering additional school tours on **Wednesday 13th, Thursday 14th and Monday, 18th June 2018**, where senior staff will be available to show you around the campus to see our very successful school. As numbers will be limited please phone the school to book a place on **01245 264451**. The guided tours will begin at 9.15am and we would ask you arrive at the school's Main Reception 9.10am. The tour will give you an opportunity to see the school in action and visit the excellent facilities we offer our students as well as an opportunity to speak with staff and students about life at The Boswells School. There is no parking available at the school, and limited availability in the area, so wherever possible we would encourage visitors to walk. We would also ask that if you are travelling by car that you park with consideration for our neighbours and do not obstruct driveways.

In addition, we are holding several events which will be notified to our local primary/junior schools giving Year 4 and 5 children an opportunity to sample life with us on specialist taster days. Details will also be posted on our web-site if parents from outside our priority admissions area wish to book. These will take place during July.

We are also holding the following events where all are welcome:

Art Exhibition – 5pm-7pm on Thursday 28th June – no tickets needed

Drama Extravaganza – 7pm on Tuesday 3rd July – tickets on sale during June via Positickets website

Celebration of Dance – Monday 9th and Tuesday 10th July – ticket on sale during June via Positickets website

This is a hugely exciting time to be part of The Boswells School Community. Our school remains extremely popular and last year, we achieved our best ever GCSE results and A Level. At GCSE level, 71% of our students achieved both English and Maths at grade 4 and above. Our students' progress from when they started with us is excellent, meaning that regardless of your child's academic ability, they will achieve outstanding results with us. Our A Level results were also the highest the school has achieved with over 55% of all grades A*-B. Our performance at GCSE/A Level made Boswells one of the highest performing schools in Essex.

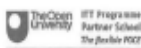
