



**Year 1 & 2 Homework Takeaway Tasks Carnival Summer 2 2018**

English	Maths	Discovery
Read to an adult at least three times a week and tell them about the book you are reading: Who are the main characters? Where does the story happen? What might happen next?	Keep a diary of your day and remember to write down what time each event occurs. This can be done with either analogue or digital times.	Keep a weather diary/complete a weather chart for a week for the weather at home.  Can you find out how hot it is in Brazil?
Write a fact file about an animal from the Amazon Rainforest.	Practise your 2, 3, 5 and 10 times tables, practice these in random orders.	Go on a nature trail around your garden or local area and record what you see, smell, touch and hear.
Write a postcard from a person from Brazil. Think about the weather and landmarks.	There are 27 stars on the Brazil flag. Can you write ten calculations with the answer 27?	Design or make a colourful carnival outfit.
Ask the adults that you live with if they have ever been to a carnival before. What was it like? What did they see? What did they hear? Write their responses in full sentences remembering capital letters and full stops.	Using blue, green and yellow, how many ways can you colour the Brazil flag?	Find a Brazilian recipe for a dish that is eaten and enjoyed by the people of Brazil. Make it if you can and share pictures of it being enjoyed by your family.
Write down as many words as you can that describes a carnival event, e.g. fun, colourful, bright etc. Can you add in similes too? Don't forget to include the carnival picture that you are describing.	Pick a number from 10-20, then another number from 1-9. Take these numbers away from each other; remember to write in full number sentences. eg $19 - 3 = 16$	Create a rainforest collage, can you show specific features of the Amazon rainforest.
Design a poster advertising one of the landmarks in Brazil, e.g. Sugarloaf Mountain or Christ the Redeemer.	Pick a number from 25-50, then another number from 1-20. Add these numbers together; remember to write in full number sentences. Eg $30 + 11 = 41$	Create a poster detailing all four seasons in the UK. What is the weather like? What can we do in each season?
Year group spellings to learn this half term are on the back of this sheet. Maybe learn five spellings each week until you can spell them all.	Read, write, and count numbers from 0-100 forwards and backwards. Ensure your numbers are formed correctly.	Write a recipe for a fruit cocktail that you have made.
Pick six spelling words and write a sentence using each word.	Read and write numbers from one to twenty in words. Think about the spellings of the words.	Make a headdress that could be worn to a Brazilian carnival.
