English	Maths	Discovery
Read to an adult at least three times a week and tell them about the book you are reading: Who are the main characters? Where does the story happen? What might happen next?	Keep a weather diary/complete a weather chart for a week for the weather at home and use the internet to chart the weather in Brazil. Show your findings in a suitable way - graph maybe. What are your main findings?	Create a drawing or model of a rainforest showing the different layers of growth; some examples of what animals would live there and labelling some species of plants.
Write a diary entry for an explorer who is discovering the Amazon.	Practise times tables so you know 4x 5x 6x 8x 12x multiplication and division facts with instant recall. Then try 7x or 9x.	Using some pictures in class or your own research on the internet can you create your own model of a favela out of recyclable materials?
Imagine you are living in the favelas. Write a diary about your day. Really put yourself in their shoes and see beyond the pictures we have shared and discussed.	How long is the River Amazon? How many people live in Brasilia? How long does it take to fly to Brazil? When was Brasilia built? Place these numbers in order. Can you double/triple each number?	Find a Brazilian recipe for a dish that is eaten and enjoyed by the people of Brazil. Write out the recipe; make it if you can and share pictures of it being enjoyed by your family.
Create a poster to encourage someone to visit Brazil.	There are six teams in a competition. They all play each other. How many matches are there? Can you write them all?	Make a model of a creature that lives in the rainforest.
What can you find out about life in Brazil? How is it different in different areas?	Have a go at the rain forest challenge on the back of this sheet	Research a Brazilian animal. Can you draw or make a model of the animal?
