Please make sure you report your child's absence to school either by phone or email before the start of the school day. You must report your child's absence everyday if they are absent from school.

Attendance

If you take a term time holiday it is extremely likely that you will incurr a fine. We have been lenient over the past year as we know families have had holidays rebooked from Covid times and it has been hard to get away. However from this term, if you do take your child out of school, the absence will not be authorised and the Local Authority may issue a penalty notice to each parent of £60 for each child to be paid within 21 days.
