Diabetes Awareness Day



Monday 14 November is Diabetes Awareness Day and we would like to mark this in school by the children wearing blue. Obviously school sweatshirts are blue so they need to be in uniform but they might like to wear additional blue accessories; hats, scarves, hair bands, nail varnish etc in support.

Lily is in reception and was diagnosed with Type 1 Diabetes at the start of the pandemic in April 2020, this was an extremely challenging time for us as a family as she was only 2 years old. Over the last two years Lily has had to overcome many things, including 5-8 daily insulin injections and multiple finger pricks, to now an insulin pump that she carries around with her 24/7 that includes applying new cannula every 3 days.

Being Type 1 means her pancreas no longer produces insulin which our body's need to

give us energy.

Lily's glucose levels need to be watched constantly throughout the day and night, as long periods of highs and sudden lows can be very serious. This can be extremely difficult to control as SO many factors can affect her glucose levels due to insulin being a hormone.

Lily truly is incredible and never complains or moans, even when newly diagnosed and obviously having no understanding of all the changes happening. We want to celebrate her bravery and positivity by wearing something blue on Monday 14 November for World Diabetes day. And to bring awareness of the symptoms as unfortunately studies have shown more children are being diagnosed since Covid has hit us. Thank you
