HOME LEARNING POLICY

This document explains our approach to home learning at Springfield Primary School.

Home learning is planned and designed to supplement and support the learning that takes place in school and enable children to consolidate and develop their understanding of key concepts. Supporting your child's learning at home will undoubtedly contribute to their progress in school so we strive to make all tasks accessible for all.

ONLINE LEARNING PLATFORMS

We utilise platforms such as Times Tables Rock Stars (TTRS), Spellzone and Bug Club to deliver home learning.

HOME LEARNING TASKS

Teachers will set home learning tasks each Wednesday for children to complete over the coming week. Standard core learning tasks are set to consolidate in school learning. The table below outlines the home learning tasks that are set weekly.

Core learning tasks
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• TTRS - Times tables practice• Spellzone - Phonics or spelling key word practice.• Reading 4 or more times a week

REWARDS

Children who read four times or more a week and record it in their reading diary will be awarded a bookworm sticker. If a bookworm sticker is earned every week in a half term, the child's name is entered into a raffle to win a brand new book.

MONITORING OF HOME LEARNING

Senior leaders monitor the home learning provision and engagement on a regular basis. The home learning policy and approach is reviewed regularly, supported by the gathering of pupil, parent and staff views.
